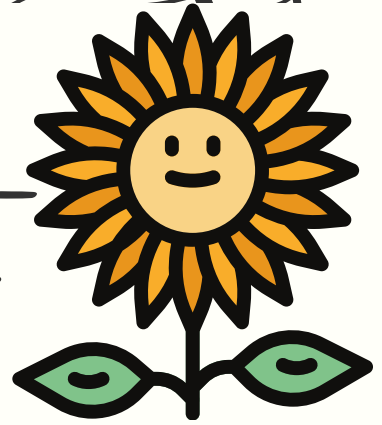


Story of me!

This project was created in the year 2020 when we are all living through some extraordinary times! It is more important than ever that we preserve our stories for future generations to learn from.

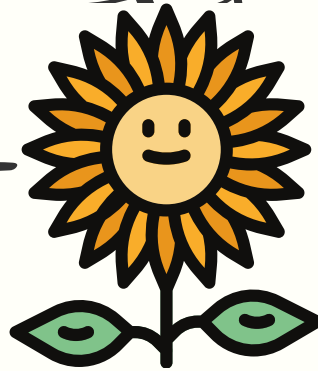
